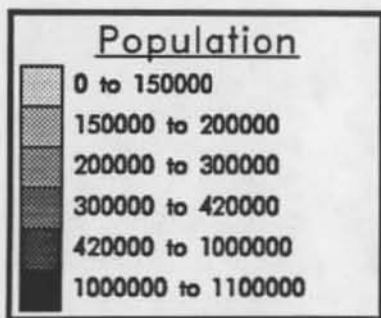
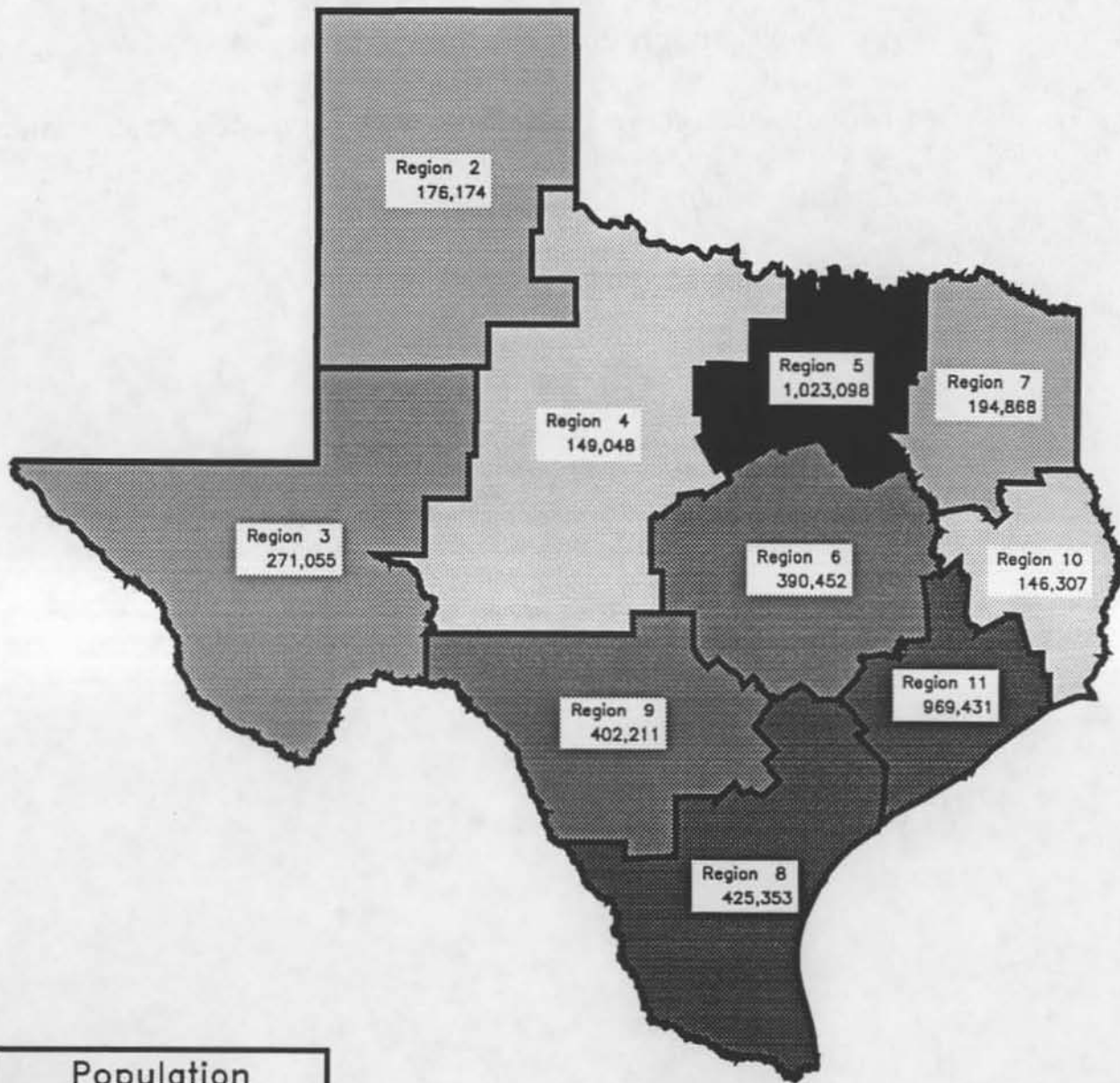

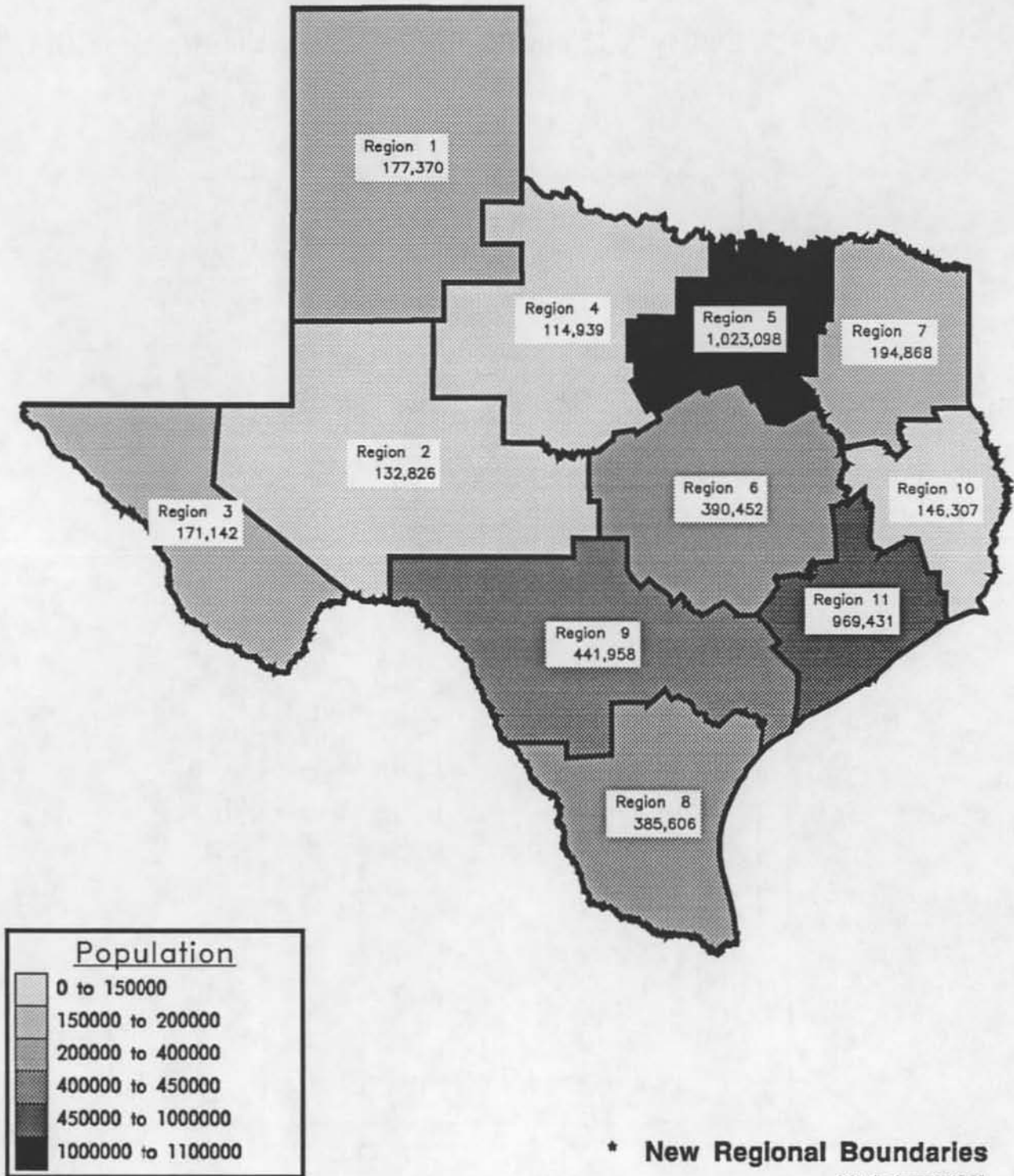

Child Population by Region (Ages 0-13)

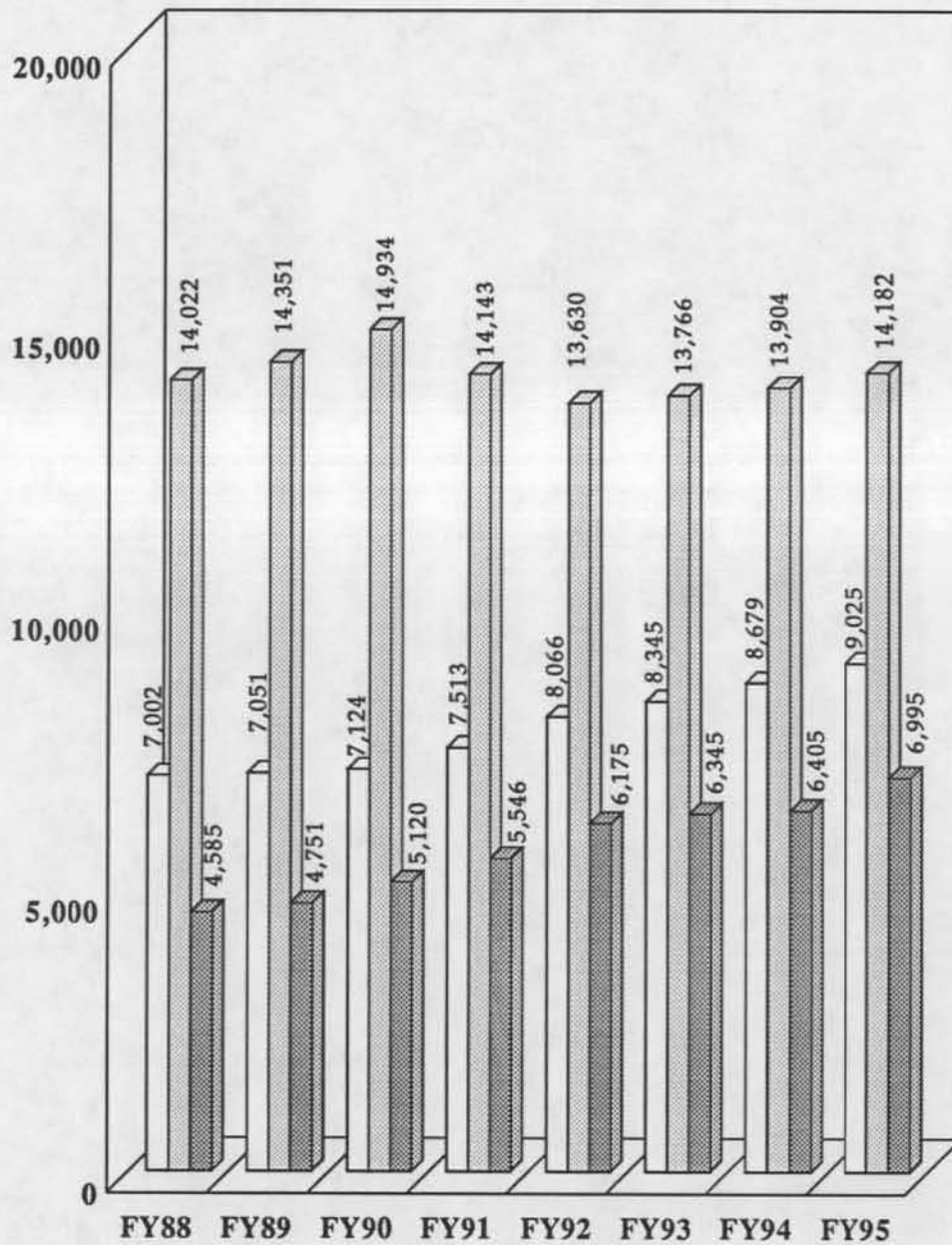

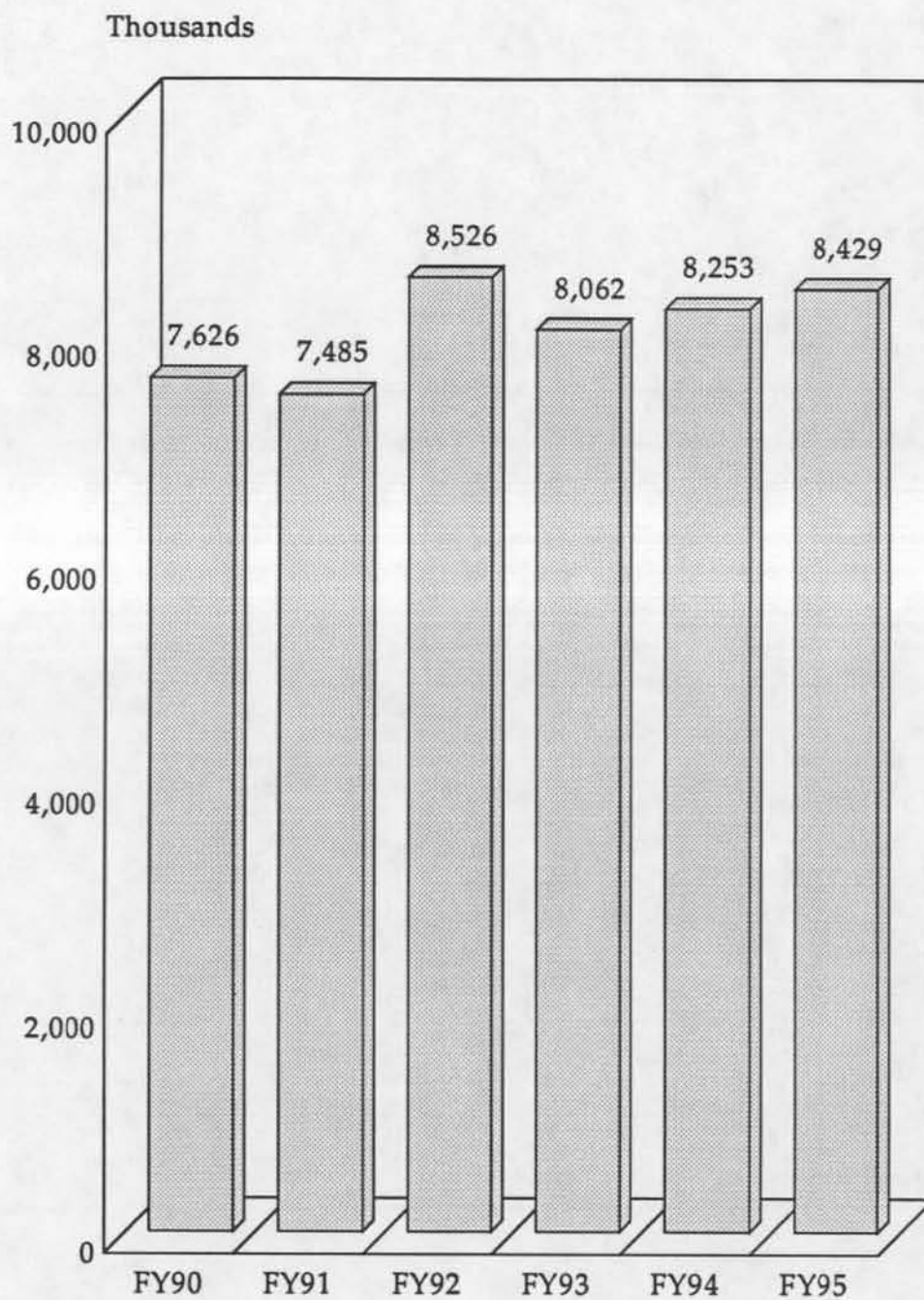
In Fiscal Year 1992, Child Care Licensing fully implemented a new field organizational structure. TDPRS regions included in these regional areas are:

- Regional Area 4 - Regions 10 and 11

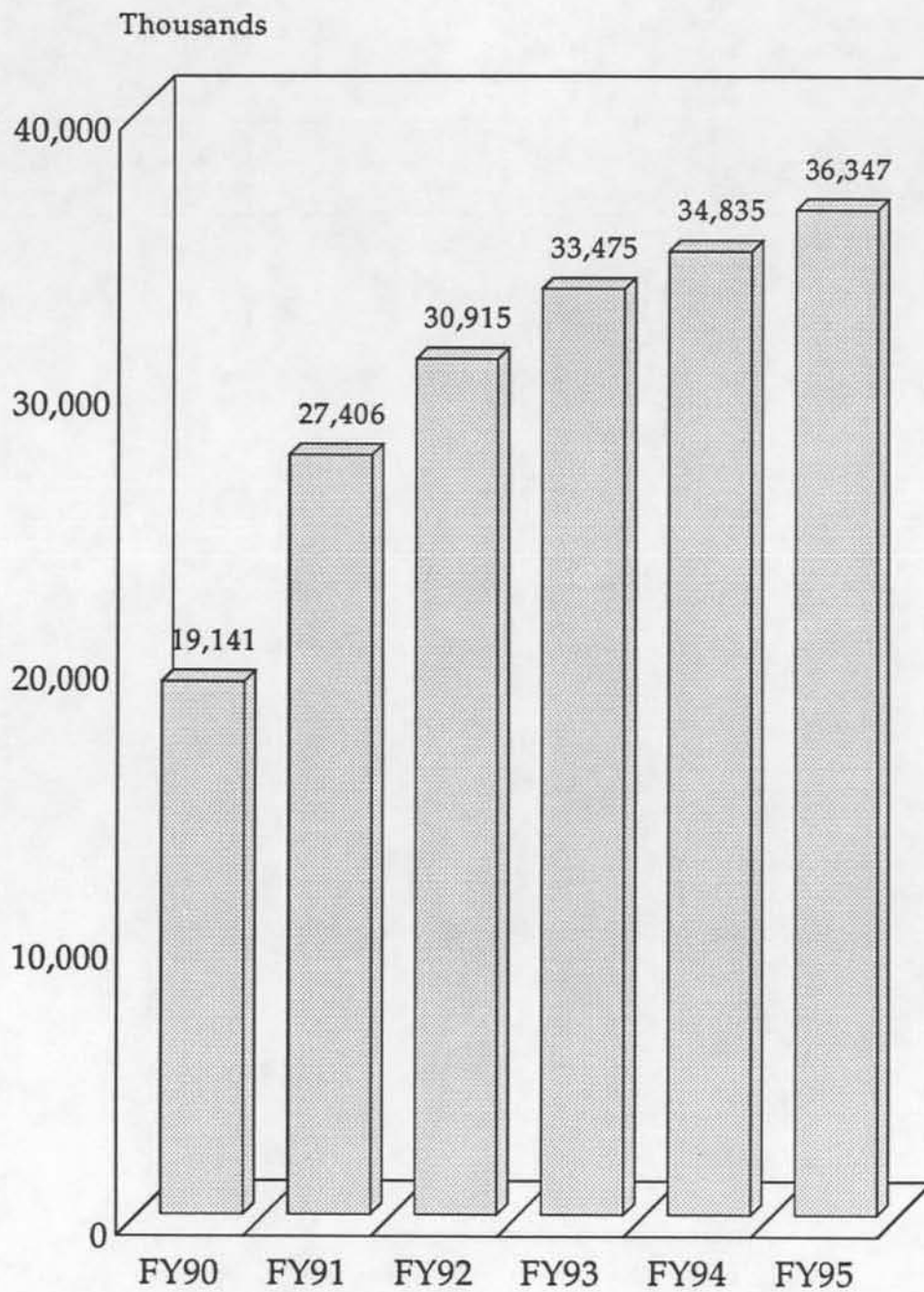

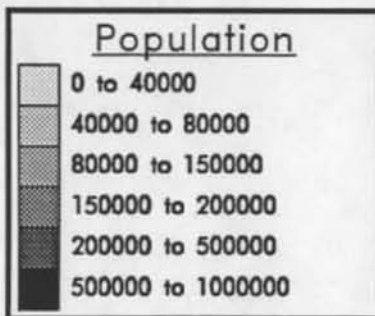
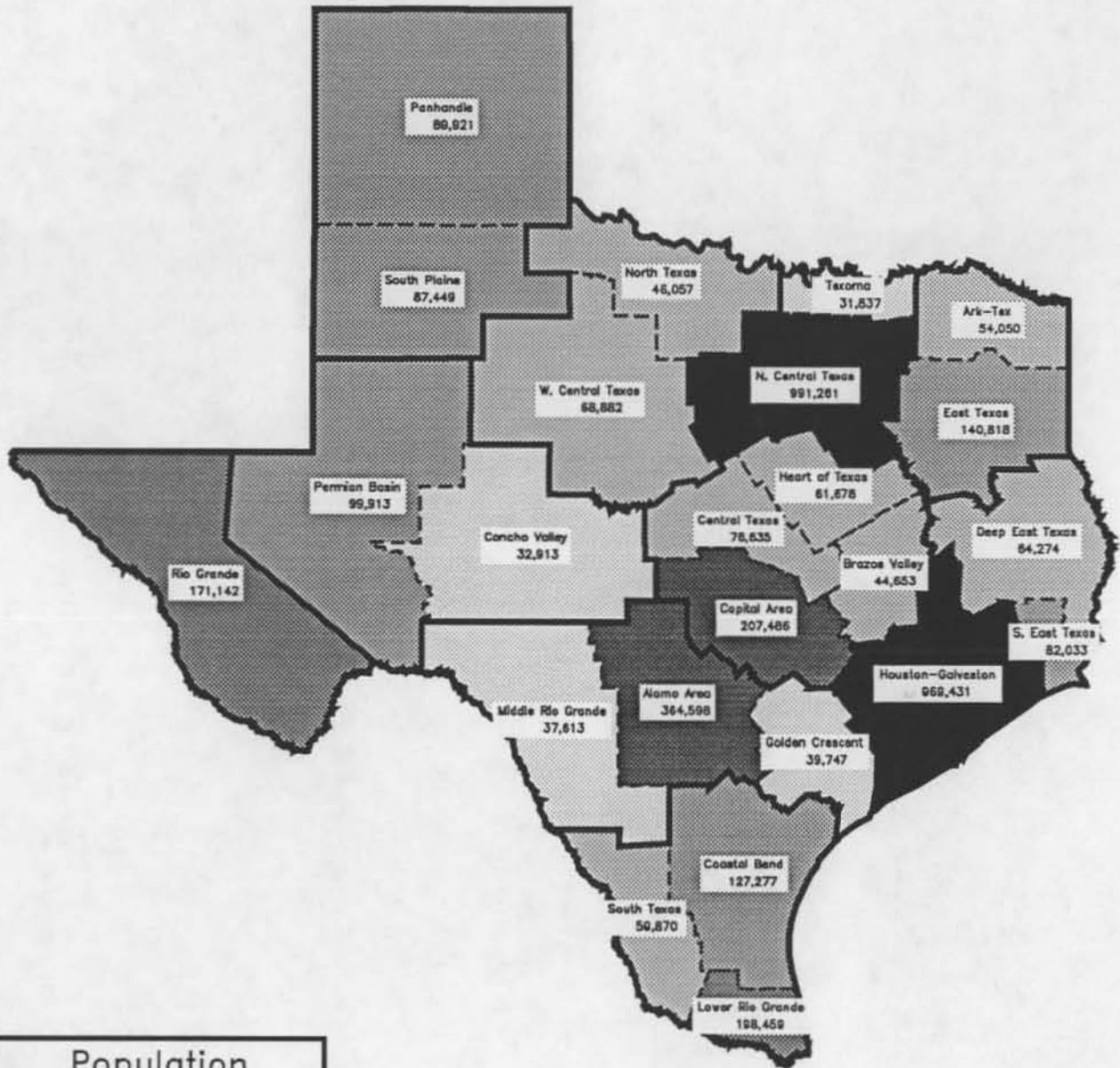
