The Adult Protective Services MH & MR Investigations Program investigates reports of abuse, neglect, and exploitation of persons with disabilities (children and adults) receiving services in state operated and/or contracted settings that serve adults and children with mental illness or mental retardation. Investigation results are sent to the facility or program administrator for appropriate action.

Notifications

The following persons are notified within one hour of the receipt of the intake:

- Facility administrator
- Law enforcement if allegations involves serious physical injury, sexual abuse, or death of an adult.
- Law enforcement of any allegation involving a child.

Investigation Activities

- Face to face contact with alleged victims
- Interview of witnesses and alleged perpetrator
- Collection of written statements and documentary evidence.
- Photographing of injuries
- Photographing/diagramming scene of incident
- Gathering other relevant evidence

Investigation Findings

- Analyze evidence
- Determine finding(s)
- Generate investigative report
- Provide report to facility administrator
- Provide report to law enforcement if investigation confirms abuse, neglect, or exploitation that may constitute a criminal offense










