<p>Under Executive Order RP 35, HHSC was directed to review and reform the CPS program. Detailed recommendations were developed and SB 6 was enacted by the 79th Legislature that outlined a comprehensive reform of DFPS to improve its services. An unprecedented increase in funding and FTEs was provided to achieve the improvements. CPS Reform funding contained in this sub-strategy provided the telecommunication and software maintenance resources for the new contract oversight and program quality assurance staff that will be needed when case management and substitute care services are outsourced.
