Beginning September 1, 2015, Superior HealthPlan will provide extra benefits and services for STAR Health members. This means members can get:



Expanded vision benefits providing prescription glasses or \$100 towards the cost of any features or frames not covered by Medicaid.



Small cash grants, called Care Grants, that may be used for items like art supplies, clothing or other personal items.



Boys and Girls Club membership for members ages 6 through 18 years old.



Age appropriate rewards (Teddy Bear or \$10 gift card) when a member goes to their 7 day follow-up appointment after their psychiatric hospital discharge.



STAR Health mobile crises services in Houston, Dallas, San Antonio, Lubbock and Corpus Christi if children/youth are placed with Pathways and Covenant Kids.



\$30 every 3 months for over-the-counter medications through a mail order program.



a2A CentAccount® Rewards Program offering rewards dollars for members completing wellness visits, dental checkups and other health screenings for members ages 18 through 21 years old.



Sports or camp physicals for members ages 4 to 18 years old.



Health Passport access through smart phones.



Online resources to help improve mental health and overall well-being.
